# Ducky Baby Quilt<sup>©</sup>

Approx. 34" X 49" Baby Quilt  
A Pearl Louise Design

## Materials Needed:

- One Lil Lucky Ducky<sup>©</sup> Panel (Center Panel)
- 1/8 Yard White Dots On Pink TRO-697 (Corner Blocks)
- 1/4 Yard White Dots On Blue TRO-697 (Corner Blocks)
- 3/4 Yard Lime Green Baby Print TRO-694 (Outer Border)
- 1/2 Yard Pink & Green Plaid TRO-693 (Binding)
- 1 1/2 Yard White Stars on Yellow TRO-695 (Backing)
- Baby Quilt Batting
- Basic Sewing Supplies

Basic Instructions: Cut all fabrics as stated. WOF (Width of Fabric)  
1/4" Seams are allowed. Press all seams to the dark fabric when possible.

## Cutting Instructions:

1. Trim the Lil Lucky Ducky<sup>©</sup> Panel allowing a 1 1/2" White Border around the panel.
2. From the White Dots on Pink: Cut One 2 1/2" X WOF Strip
3. From the White Dots on Blue Cut:
  - Two 2 1/2" X WOF Strips
  - From One White Dot on Blue Strip Cut Four 2 1/2" Squares
4. From the Lime Green Baby Print Cut: Four 6 1/2" X WOF Strips  
Cut Two 6 1/2" X 22 1/2" Top and Bottom Borders. Cut Two 6 1/2" X 37 1/2" Side Borders.
5. From the Pink & Green Plaid Binding Fabric Cut: Five 2 1/2" X WOF Strips

## Building the Quilt

1. Place a 2 1/2" White Dot on Pink and a White Dot on Blue strip right sides together. Sew together and press. Cut this strip unit into Sixteen 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" Sections. Lay out the Four Nine Patch Blocks in rows. Sew a 2 1/2" White on Blue Dot Square in place as needed. With right sides together sew the three rows together. Sew the Nine Patch Blocks onto the ends of the top and bottom borders.
2. With right sides together sew the side borders onto the center panel.
3. Sew the top and bottom borders in place.
4. Sew the 2 1/2" Pink and Green Plaid Binding strips together end to end. Fold wrong sides together lengthwise and press.
5. Layer, quilt and bind the quilt as desired. Enjoy!!
