TECHNIQUE USED: Crochet



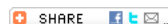
FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Shawl measures approximately
21"/53.5cm wide by 64"/162.5cm
long

MATERIALS
Caron International's Dazzleaire
(80% Acrylic, 20% Nylon; 3
oz/85g; 164 yds/150m): 9 oz
Shown in: #0014 Black
One size US K-10.5 (6.5mm)
crochet hook or size to obtain
gauge.
Yarn needle

GAUGE
In pattern, 2 pattern repeats =
6"/15cm and 4 rows = 5"/12.5cm.

STITCHES USED
Chain (ch), single crochet (sc),
treble crochet (tr)

SPECIAL STITCH
shell: ([Tr, ch 2] 4 times, tr) in indicated stitch.

SHAWL

Ch 72.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk next 4 ch, ([tr, ch 2] 4 times, tr) in next ch (shell made), sk next 4 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn—7 pattern repeats.

Row 2: Ch 8 (counts as tr, ch 4), sc in 3rd tr (middle) of first shell, *ch 4, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next sc (between shells), ch 4, sc in 3rd tr of next shell; repeat from * across, ch 4, tr in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as tr, ch 2), (tr, ch 2, tr) in first tr, sc in next sc, *shell in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, ([tr, ch 2] twice, tr) in 4th ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first tr, ch 4, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next sc, *ch 4, sc in 3rd tr of next shell, ch 4, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next sc; repeat from * across, ch 4, sc in 4th ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *shell in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Rows 6–65: Repeat Rows 2–5. **Note:** The last row you work will be a Row 5.

Fasten off.

Beginning Edge Trim

Note: Trim worked across opposite side of foundation ch makes both edges of shawl look the same, with shells along both edges.

With RS facing and working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in first ch, *sk next 4 ch, shell in next ch (at base of next shell on Row 1), sk next 4 ch, sc in next ch (at base of next sc on Row 1); repeat from * across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.
